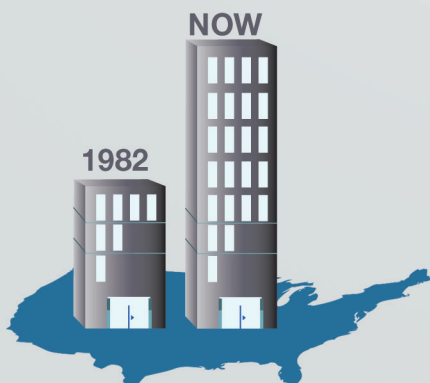

2/3 of all present-day college students intend to become entrepreneurs.

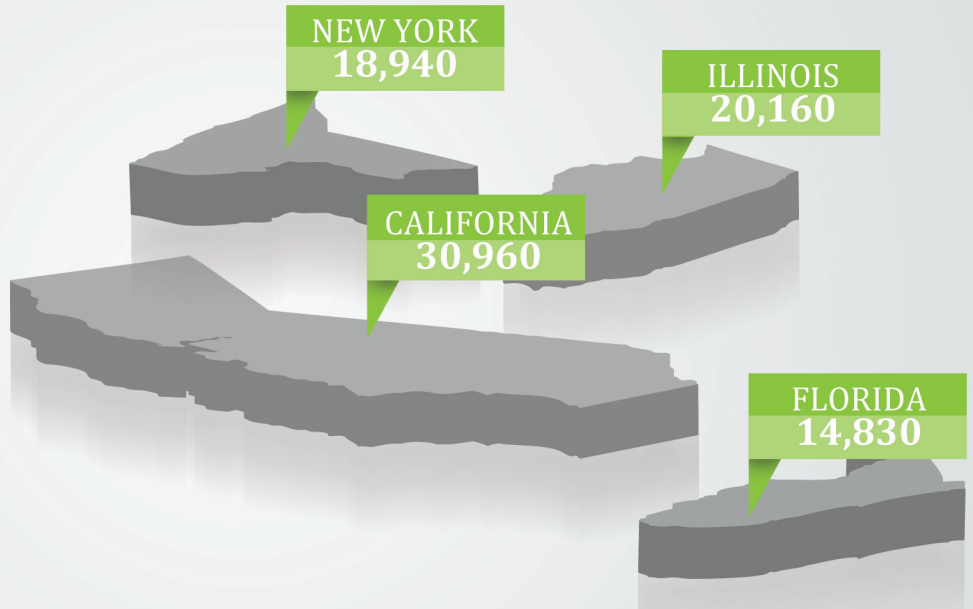


Small businesses added 8 million new jobs since 1990.
