



IRS Tax Volunteers to Support CBT College Initiative

Learn to Prepare Taxes and Make a Difference at the same time. How can you make a difference? Simple. Help our community in preparing taxes free of charge by becoming a volunteer with the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program.

You will receive training to provide free tax help for low to moderate income families who need assistance preparing their tax returns. Over 90,000 people said yes to make a difference during the 2019 filing season and prepared over 3.7 million returns at thousands of tax sites nationwide.

How does this program work? As a committed Tax Volunteer you'll be assigned to work with a CBT College location, first to receive training and then to begin volunteering at a location in our community. Training is offered both online and in the classroom. Tax sites are generally open days and nights. You will be sure to find a volunteer site close to you.

CBT College has four locations where we provide this community service: Flagler and Hialeah, and our tax preparation season starts on February 2019. We need your help on these two positions. Candidates who only speak Spanish are also welcome.

Tax Preparer – You complete and successfully certify in tax law training, including the use of electronic filing software, to provide free tax return preparation for eligible taxpayers.

Quality Reviewer – You review tax returns completed by volunteer tax preparers, ensuring that every taxpayer receives top quality service and that the tax returns are error-free. You must be tax law certified at least at the Intermediate level.
